## **DOCUMENTATION & RECORDS**

[] Copy of the original bail order
[] Proof of compliance with bail conditions (e.g., police station visits, court appearances)
[] Travel records (if accused of leaving jurisdiction)
[] Employment certificate or ID (to show stability)
[] Residential proof (rental agreement, electricity bill, etc.)
[] Character/reference letters (from employer, community leader, etc.)
[] Counter affidavit in reply to cancellation petition
LEGAL PREPARATION
[] Review of cancellation grounds mentioned by the complainant/police
[] Draft point-wise reply to each allegation
[] Identify contradictions or lack of evidence in the cancellation petition
[] Prepare witnesses (if any) who can confirm compliance or good conduct
[] Check for any procedural lapse (e.g., no notice served)
STRATEGY & COURTROOM READINESS
[] Be aware of previous case laws relevant to your facts (e.g., Daulat Ram v. State of Haryana)
[] Prepare oral arguments or statements with your lawyer
[] Ensure you or your lawyer has a copy of the FIR, charge sheet, and any new allegations
[] Be punctual and respectfully dressed for court appearance
[] Maintain calm and disciplined body language in court
POST-ORDER CONTINGENCIES
[] If bail is cancelled: file appeal or revision petition immediately
[] Apply for interim relief or fresh bail if advised by lawyer
